The heart of everything God has done has been to have a relationship with His people. When we rejected Him, when we put ourselves into a position that was both opposite of Him and detrimental for us, He did what was necessary to reconcile.

- I. The Regeneration of Reconciliation 14-16
 - A. We were dead spiritually
 - B. He died for us physically
 - C. So we can live spiritually
- II. The Ministry of Reconciliation 17-19
 - A. Reconciled through Christ
 - 1. Made sin for us
 - 2. Though He knew no sin
 - 3. Paying that debt
 - B. Making us a new creature
 - 1. Alive to spiritual things
 - a) Spiritually aware
 - b) Spiritually strong
 - 2. Capable of better things
 - a) Resisting temptation
 - b) Having a better mindset
- III. The Requirements of Reconciliation
 - A. We are ambassadors
 - 1. We speak on behalf of our King
 - 2. We bring honor to our King in a foreign land
 - a) Which means we behave ourselves

- B. We seek to see others reconciled
 - 1. The lost
 - 2. The backslidden
- C. We don't rekindle the argument
 - 1. "If you love me keep my commandments"
 - 2. Ephesians 4:30
 - ³⁰ And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
